

So this should be a pretty simple 98 card print. 11 double-sided pages. Page 2 is the back of page 1. Flip horizontally, book-style. I don't know if that's the proper printing lingo but I believe it's understandable.

74 Word Cards with 148 Word Sets, 24 Limit Cards. One blank card because that is where the manual would fit in the real box. Number cards are a separate pdf and entirely optional.

There are 3-by-3 cards each page, at 2.5"x3.5" each card should fit within .25" margins (and easily in A4 size margin).

So, just in case, a single-sided print is okay too. The limit cards don't really need a backside printed, just something to distinguish from the word cards. You could technically print Word Cards all single-sided - it would only lose the fact that the word set on the other side is a different option with a different difficulty. You can just draw a few single-sided cards and pick one for nearly the same effect.

Secondly, the number card pdf comes with 42 completely unnecessary rhyming word sets. The number cards, also, aren't entirely necessary - you can roll a die instead. But I put considerable effort into determining these rhyming sets so I just need to put them out there, though they are so very silly for the main game.
